In 2001, Ms. Sharma helped found Advocacy Forum, a Nepali NGO that has played an instrumental role in defending the rights of Nepali people caught in the brutal civil war between Maoist insurgents and the Nepali government, during which more than 13,000 Nepalis were killed.

She has won several national and international awards including Human Rights Defender of the Year Award, presented by Human Rights Watch, NY, 2006 .
